Miazma Chenin Blanc 2006

This wine is refreshing in the mouth with a light body, subtle fruit and balanced alcohol. The fruits balance the acidity, and the sweet notes on the palate make this wine an easy companion to pair with most spicy foods.

Kingfisher Bohemia Chenin Blanc Chardonnay 2007

This blended white wine has pineapple and ripe melon flavours on the nose, which follows through to a limy, full middle-palate and finishes in crisp freshness.

Hill & Dale Sauvignon Blanc 2007

The colour is brilliantly clear with green tints. The nose is a strong aroma of guava and peach along with gooseberries, green peppers and herbs. This wine is lively and fresh with loads of fruit flavours, a youthful vibrancy and fresh appeal.

Le Bonheur Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Brilliant colour with a greenish tint. A powerful nose with tropical fruit including grapefruit, passion fruit and mango. The tropical fruit flavours perceived on the nose carry through to the palate creating a lively amalgam of flavours.

Hill & Dale Chardonnay 2007

A brilliant lime green colour with a bouquet of butterscotch and honey with citrus fruit. The palate is full-bodied with delicate spice, vanilla oak and a creamy finish.

Kingfisher Bohemia Pinotage 2005

An uncomplicated, easy drinking Pinotage, filled with ripe berry fruit, ending with a soft sweet finish. A disappointing example of what South Africa can produce.

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Warrra River Shiraz Cabernet 2006

Incredible dark purple red colour. Smokey, spicy with lots of fruit and some jammy aromas with a well-balanced, fruity taste. It has depth and with a bit of added time to let it breathe. It is an easy drinking wine.

Miazma Shiraz 2006

A well rounded wine with subtle tones of red berries, clove, star anise and mild spices.

Pendulum Grand Reserve Shiraz 2005

Deep mulberry red colour supported by aromas of white pepper and rich ripe dark berry fruit. This intensively rich Barossa Valley wine features generous layers of exotic berries, plums, and spices set against integrated oak and soft fine-grained tannins.

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
